

INTERSTATE MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT
GENERAL USE GUIDELINES AND PARK RULES

Within any of the District's recreational facilities; it shall be unlawful for any person to do any of the following acts, except as may be otherwise provided:

- (a) swimming or wading;
- (b) use motorized vehicles, including motorized boats; provided, however, use of remote controlled boats less than forty-eight inches in length shall be permitted;
- (c) use of the recreational facilities is permitted between sunrise and sunset;
- (d) fish or net other aquatic life; provided, however, that catch and release fishing is permissible;
- (e) feed, harass, kill or catch alligators;
- (f) walk pets without a leash;
- (g) construct floating decks, docks, or other structures that extend into the recreational facilities, except those that are authorized and approved by the District and relevant homeowners association in which the proposed structure is to be located;
- (h) play loud music;
- (i) construct, fill or dredge within the boundaries of the Facilities, except as specifically authorized and approved by the District and the relevant home owners association in connection with item (f), above.
- (j) carry or discharge any firecrackers, rockets, torpedoes, other fireworks, air guns, bows, arrows, blowguns, darts or slingshots;
- (k) carry any firearms, except those persons duly authorized and licensed by the State of Texas to carry a concealed handgun in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Concealed Handgun Act;
- (l) discharge any firearm;

- (m) hitch, fasten, lead, drive or let loose any kind of animal or fowl; provided that this shall not apply to dogs or house cats when led by cord or chain not more than six feet long;
- (n) leave animal waste;
- (o) damage, cut, break, injure, deface or disturb any tree, shrub, plant, rock, monument, fence, bench, picnic table or other structure, apparatus or property;
- (p) cut or remove any wood, turf, grass, soil, rock, sand, gravel, landscape material or fertilizer, except as specifically authorized and approved by the District and the relevant home owners association in connection with item (f), above.
- (q) bring in and or dispose of outside garbage;
- (r) leave garbage, cans, bottles, papers or other refuse within the recreational facilities in places other than in trash receptacles provided therefore;
- (s) fires or burning of any kind;
- (t) carry glass bottles of any type;
- (u) carry and/or consume alcoholic beverages of any type;
- (v) sell or offer for sale any food, drinks, confections, merchandise or services unless such person has a written agreement or permit issued by the District;
- (w) camp overnight;
- (x) play or bet at or against any game that is played, conducted, dealt or carried on with cards, dice or other device, for money, chips, shells, credit or any other representative of value, or maintaining or exhibiting any gambling table or other instrument of gambling or gaming;
- (y) use any threatening, abusive or insulting language or language otherwise constituting "fighting words";
- (z) commit any obscene, lewd or indecent act or creating a nuisance of any kind;

- (aa) disturb in any manner any picnic, meeting, service, concert, exercise or exhibition;
- (bb) distribute, post, place or erect any advertising, handbill, circular, bill, notice, paper or other advertising device; and
- (cc) practice, carry on, conduct or solicit for any trade, occupation, business or profession.

Any person, corporation or other entity violating these guidelines and rules may be subject to a fine of up to \$10,000 per violation or criminal penalties, including imprisonment, or both.
